Georgia Families®



Overview

Georgia Families[®] is a managed care program through which healthcare services are delivered to around 2 million members of Medicaid, PeachCare for Kids[®], Planning for Healthy Babies[®], and Georgia Pathways to Coverage[®].

The Department of Community Health (DCH) contracts with Care Management Organizations (CMOs) to provide benefits and services to Georgia Families® members. DCH currently contracts with the following CMOs: Amerigroup, CareSource, and Peach State Health Plan. Georgia Families® allows members to select a healthcare plan that fits their needs by providing choice. The Medical Assistance Plans (MAP) division of DCH also monitors the CMOs to ensure compliance with federal and state requirements for contract management, along with member, provider, and quality services.

Program Description

Georgia Families[®] provides health care services to children enrolled in Medicaid, PeachCare for Kids[®], Georgia Pathways to Coverage, and certain men, women, children, including pregnant women and women with breast or cervical cancer covered by Medicaid.

Coverage excludes children, youth and young adults in foster care, those receiving adoption assistance, and certain youth in the juvenile justice system who are enrolled in Georgia Families 360° with a single CMO (Amerigroup).


The remainder of Georgia's Medicaid population, which includes aged, blind, and disabled citizens, are covered in fee-for-service Medicaid.

Included Populations

- PeachCare for Kids®
- Parent/Caretaker with Children Medicaid
- Transitional Medicaid
- Pregnant Women with Children Under 19
- Newborns
- Women Eligible Due to Breast and Cervical Cancer

Excluded Populations

- Aged, Blind and Disabled
- Nursing Home
- Hospice
- Foster Care Youth
- Children Receiving Adoptive Assistance
- Certain Youth in the Juvenile Justice System



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Benefits

Georgia Families[®] members receive the same benefits that are offered to Medicaid and PeachCare for Kids[®] members enrolled in traditional fee-for-service Medicaid. CMOs are also contracted to focus on health and wellness by providing members with additional benefits such as:

- Added member education about how to get care, referrals to specialists, member benefits
- Wellness and prevention programs
- Expanded access to plans and providers

Providers participating in Georgia Families[®] will receive assistance from the CMOs on educating members about accessing care, referrals to specialists, member benefits, and health and wellness education.
