

Just had a baby? Rolling off Pregnancy Medicaid?

WHAT IS P4HB?

Planning for Healthy Babies provides no-cost family planning services to eligible Georgia residents. You may be eligible for:

- Pregnancy testing and counseling, birth control, STD screening & treatment, and annual exams (including pap smears)
- Inter-Pregnancy Care (IPC): Family planning, nurse case manager, and additional services for individuals who have delivered a baby weighing less than 3 lbs, 5 oz. Receive services for 24 months.
- Access to a Resource Mother: Specially trained case manager to provide assistance to individuals already receiving Medicaid that have delivered a baby weighing less than 3 lbs, 5 oz. Receive services for 24 months.

WHAT IS COVERED?

- Annual physical exams (including pap smears)
- Birth control and multivitamins with folic acid
- Family planning counseling
- IPC services including primary care & dental services, substance abuse treatment services, mental health services, a Resource Mother, etc.
- If you had a very low birthweight baby, you can also receive primary care & dental services, substance abuse treatment services, a Resource Mother, etc.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Women ages 18-44 who meet monthly family income limits
- If you receive Medicaid and delivered a baby weighing less than 3 lbs, 5 oz, you are eligible for only Resource Mother services.
- If you do not receive Medicaid, you are eligible for family planning services.
- If you do not receive Medicaid or are losing coverage, and delivered a baby weighing less than 3 lbs, 5 oz, you are eligible for IPC services.
