ANALYSES OF HOSPITAL STATISTICAL AND REIMBURSEMENT (HS&R) REPORT SUBMISSIONS

QUARTER 2: APRIL 2015 THROUGH JUNE 2015

JANUARY 12, 2016





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PROJECT BACKGROUND

The Medicaid Care Management Organizations Act (the "Act") requires the Care Management Organizations (CMOs) to provide a Hospital Statistical and Reimbursement (HS&R) report within 30 (thirty) days upon request of a provider. Specifically, O.C.G.A. 33-21A-11 states:

Upon request by a hospital provider related to a specific fiscal year, a care management organization shall, within 30 days of the request, provide that hospital with an HS&R report for the requested fiscal year. Any care management organization which violates this Code section by not providing the requested report within 30 days shall be subject to a penalty of \$1,000.00 per day, starting on the thirty-first day after the request and continuing until the report is provided. It is the intent of the General Assembly that such penalty be collected by the Department of Community Health and deposited into the Indigent Care Trust Fund created pursuant to Code Section 31-8-152. A care management organization shall not reduce the funding available for health care services for members as a result of payment of such penalties.

Additionally, the CMOs must submit a list of the requested HS&R reports to the Department of Community Health ("the Department" or DCH) no later than thirty days following the calendar quarter period.





OBJECTIVE

As requested by the Department, Myers and Stauffer LC (Myers and Stauffer) tested the information included on the quarterly HS&R reports submitted by the CMOs in response to the Act for the quarter beginning April 1, 2015 and ending June 30, 2015 ("Quarter 2"). We attempted to confirm the information reported by the CMOs to demonstrate their compliance with the HS&R reporting requirements of the Act.

The quarterly HS&R reports submitted to the Department by the CMOs contain the following data: the identification of hospitals that requested HS&R reports including location, name of report requestor, date the HS&R report(s) were requested, the date the CMO released the report to the hospital or requestor, and other related information.

Using the HS&R reports provided by each CMO, we attempted to confirm no less than five report requests for each respective CMO. The Methodology section provides an overview of how we analyzed the data on the quarterly reports.





METHODOLOGY

In order to perform this analysis, we utilized the quarterly reports submitted to DCH by each of the CMOs. WellCare of Georgia (WellCare) report was obtained by accessing their web portal on August 31, 2015. The reports for Peach State Health Plan's (PSHP) and Amerigroup Community Care (AGP) were obtained via email on August 31, 2015. For Quarter 2, 59 HS&R reports were reported by the CMOs and can be found in Exhibit A of this report.

In accordance with the confirmation process approved by DCH, Myers and Stauffer requests confirmation of the CMO-reported request and release dates from providers, or their representatives, when the CMO-reported release date is 30 days or greater from the CMO-reported request date. With DCH's approval, HS&R reports were randomly selected for AGP, PSHP, and WellCare to contact providers for confirmation of the dates reported by the CMOs.

Telephone calls or e-mails regarding 30 HS&R reports were initiated on September 9, 2015 and completed on September 28, 2015. Providers were asked to provide the date they requested the HS&R report and the date the CMO provided notification that the report was available.

A maximum of three attempts per provider were performed in an effort to acquire data for this analysis.

Once the data was collected, we analyzed the results and performed follow-up communication as necessary. Provider responses were compared with the dates reported on each CMO's quarterly report.





ASSUMPTIONS AND LIMITATIONS

The assumptions and limitations summarized below should be noted when reviewing this report.

- Our procedures were not designed to identify instances where a CMO may have failed to include a provider's request for an HS&R report in the CMO's report to DCH. However, had instances occurred where a provider stated they requested an HS&R report from a CMO that was not included in the CMO's report to DCH, Myers and Stauffer would have communicated with the respective CMO to confirm the information obtained from the provider.
- Myers and Stauffer accepted a verbal or an email confirmation for information received from providers.
- As instructed by the Department, if the due date of the report, 30 days after the report was requested, fell on a Saturday or Sunday, the next business day was assumed to be the due date for purposes of this analysis.





ANALYTICAL FINDINGS

This section provides a summary of our findings. Detailed findings can be found in Exhibit B.

As illustrated in the table above, we have included the total number of reports each respective CMO reported to the Department for Quarter 2. The findings indicate for 96.7 percent (29 of 30) of the HS&R reports, the providers were able to confirm the information reported by the CMOs. One provider representing one report request confirmed receipt of the report but could not validate the CMO reported dates. There were two reports released 30 or more days after provider's request.

The statistics included in Table II are based on the dates provided within the CMO quarterly reports. Although the dates given to Myers and Stauffer by the providers were considered in the analysis, documentation provided by the CMOs was used to confirm the dates reported to DCH by the CMOs.





SUMMARY

AMERIGROUP

For Quarter 2, Myers and Stauffer did not identify any HS&R reports released by Amerigroup to a provider that were greater than 30 days. Seven representatives were contacted regarding ten HS&R report requests. The request and release dates reported by the CMO were confirmed for ten requests.

PEACH STATE HEALTH PLAN

For Quarter 2, Five representatives were contacted regarding ten HS&R report requests. The request and release dates reported by the CMO were confirmed for ten requests. Myers and Stauffer identified two HS&R reports released by Peach State to a provider that were greater than 30 days. Details of the late HS&R reports can be found in Exhibit D of this report. We requested clarification regarding the late reports from Peach State Health Plan. Claudette Bazille at Peach State Health Plan responded with the following:

"Upon investigation we learned that we received the HS&R request from Michelle Morris on 05/26/2015 as shown below. During the first 2 quarters of the year we had a great deal of internal transition. Therefore a temporary employee was handling the handoff of the HS&R reports after they were received. We found several emails between the temp and Michelle related to the fact that the original request contained incorrect facility information which yielded unpopulated reports when executed by our IT team. While waiting for the updated facility information the temp was unexpectedly separated from her position. During the transition, the IT department failed to notify the new employee, Willie Slaton, that it was waiting for the corrected facility information from the temp. Consequently, the HS&R request for South Georgia Health System was submitted beyond the allotted turnaround time. Currently, Willie handles the requests in house and tracks receipt, follow up, and submission through separate process. Additional staff members are used for support purposes only."

WELLCARE

For Quarter 2, Myers and Stauffer did not identify any HS&R reports released by WellCare to a provider that were greater than 30 days. Seven representatives were contacted regarding ten HS&R report requests. The request and release dates reported by the CMO were confirmed for nine requests. One provider acknowledged receipt of the requested report, but was unable to validate CMO reported dates.





SUMMARY OF POTENTIAL PENALTIES

Based on the findings for Peach State Health Plan, there are potential penalties for late reporting that DCH may elect to assess for the quarter beginning April 1, 2015 and ending June 30, 2015.

For the two cases of late reporting, 8 days were determined to be late. Georgia statute (O.C.G.A. 33-21A-11) states, "...Any care management organization which violates this Code section by not providing the requested report within 30 days shall be subject to a penalty of \$1,000.00 per day, starting on the thirty first day after the request and continuing until the report is provided."

Pursuant to the statutory and contractual requirements, DCH may elect to impose penalties of up to \$8,000 on Peach State Health Plan.
