What is GA CHIPRA?

The Georgia Children's
Health Insurance Program
Reauthorization Act
(GA CHIPRA) Premium
Assistance Program may
pay for private, employersponsored health insurance
coverage for Medicaid
members under the age of 19.





What are the benefits of participating in the GA CHIPRA Program?

The GA CHIPRA program may provide:

- Medicaid payments for healthcare services not covered by Medicaid
- · Access to a larger network of providers
- Coverage for family members, including those not eligible for Medicaid



How do I know if I qualify for GA CHIPRA?

To qualify, you or a member of your family must:

- » Be a Medicaid member under the age of 19.
- » Have an employer who pays at least 40% of your health insurance premium costs.

How do I apply for GA CHIPRA?

It's easy to apply for the GA CHIPRA Program:



Step 1: Complete the application form and fax or mail it to the GA CHIPRA office.



Step 2: If you qualify, GA CHIPRA will begin reimbursing your monthly premium. If you are not already enrolled in your employer's health insurance plan, you will need to enroll and begin paying the monthly premium to receive your reimbursements.

What happens after I am enrolled in GA CHIPRA?



You'll be asked to:

- Send proof of premium payment to the GA CHIPRA Unit each month (acceptable proof includes copies of pay stubs, bank statements, money order receipts, credit card statements, and letters from employers). GA CHIPRA will reimburse you for your payment the following month.*
- Show your Medicaid and health insurance cards to your healthcare provider during your visit.
- Contact the GA CHIPRA office if your Medicaid eligibility, insurance coverage, or employment status changes.
- * If you are receiving health insurance through COBRA or while on a leave of absence and the reimbursement method is not possible, GA CHIPRA can pay premiums directly to your employer or insurance provider.
